- l. This INDEX includes circulars issued by Hq USFET and Hq EUCOM, weekly directives issued by Hq EUCOM, standing operating procedures issued by Hq USFET and Hq EUCOM, and multiple addressee command letter directives issued by Hq USFET and Hq EUCOM (except those classified higher than RESTRICTED) which were in effect on 1 October 1948. It is published for the information and guidance of all concerned.
- 2. For the purpose of this INDEX, "multiple addressee command letters" are construed to mean command letters (as distinguished from technical letters) issued by Hq USFET or Hq EUCOM which are addressed to all or the majority of major commands of the European Command and which contain matter of general interest and continuing application.
- 3. Omission from the INDEX of a section of a weekly directive or of a multiple addressee letter directive not previously rescinded by administrative action, indicates that the section of the weekly directive or letter has served the purpose for which it was originally intended and is automatically rescinded upon receipt of the INDEX.
- 4. It is desired that staff divisions of this headquarters review circulars, weekly directives, standing operating procedures and multiple addressee command letters for which they are responsible and recommend necessary rescissions in those cases where such directives are no longer applicable.
