I found out today that my case in the Jewish Court of Honor in Munich became active. I hope you will agree be my defense attorney and take the attached mandate.

Whatever you need to know from me either in writing or verbally, please let me know and I will be at your service immediately.

You probably didn't expect me to contact you under such circumstances, but life can't spare anybody.

In the most difficult of times, I was exercising difficult and responsible functions with my full commitment and engagement. I didn't expect that one day I would have to explain to anyone what I was doing, but life doesn't spare anybody!
