In Beth Chalutzoth – in the Hamburg Barracks, Room No. 305. Room 305, in the House of Chalutzim, officially in the Hamburg Barracks, was home for Else Lichtblau (Elsa Leskly) and 25 other Jewish women. Erich Lichtblau recalls: *Every Friday evening there was Oneg Shabbat. They young people sang Hebrew songs and they learned Hebrew language. They lived with the dream to go after the liberation to Palestine.* Terezin, 1943.
