Sylvester 1942: New Year Eve Prophecy. The last verse makes people believe that one day, next year (1943) the Jews led by G-D will return to Prague. The English-German translation sounds as follows:

Because one of the coming 365 days Is surely the one, of which Jewish history will say in the future

In this month, on that day Baruch Hashem, the Jews will be led to Prague.

Overall, authorship of the poem is ascribed to Erich Lichtblau. There is a reference to an unknown woman as to a probable author of this poem. This reference comes from Erich Lichtblau's recollections.
