Fellow Radicals, Idealists, and Malcontents:

During the past year, we have been steadily improving THE LIBERTY BELL. Even the clean-cut, more legible typographical design we introduced a few months ago proclaims the general change for the better.

In recent issues of THE LIBERTY BELL we have reprinted such rare and valuable works as Dietrich Eckart's Bolshevism from Moses to Lenin, Michael F. Conner's The Development of Germanophobia, and Francis Parker Yockey's The Destiny of America. We have also presented a wealth of original material which, before the advent of THE LIBERTY BELL, would never have got into print: Ralph Perier's stunningly controversial examination of race and religion, Donald Vincent Clerkin's cogent reply thereto, the thought-provoking essays of Ronald Hand and Carl Alessi, and the no-holds-barred Whiteman's Guidebook. In our May and June issues we published the first English-language edition of Francis Parker Yockey's The Enemy of Europe, the long-suppressed conclusion to his monumental work Imperium. Our next two issues will contain a penetrating critique of Yockey's thought by the eminent scholar Revilo P. Oliver. And much, much more is in the offing.

Now a quantitative improvement must follow the qualitative one. THE LIBERTY BELL does not have the circulation a journal that publishes such outstanding material deserves, nor is it on as sound a fiscal basis as it should be. Although our printer is the only one connected with THE LIBERTY BELL who receives a salary, we pay as much for paper, ink, photographic supplies, mailing envelopes, postage, and the like as does any other publisher. With pages of advertising from Fords and Bronfmans, the Establishment ragazines get leaner, shoddier, and dearer every time the Postal "Service" decides to squeeze the consumer for another nickel. But we have not subtracted pages from THE LIBERTY BELL or reduced the quality of the paper, and it was with great reluctance that we recently increased our subscription rates. While the duodecimo format of THE LIBERTY BELL helps us publish books and pamphlets quickly and economically, it forces us to sell the periodical at a price that discourages bulk orders and prevents us from distributing free sample copies to promote circulation, as we could do if we published a tabloid. Unlike certain "right wing" sheets, we have no profitable sidelines. We do not sell gold and silver trinkets, tear gas zappers, vitamins, cancer cures, dehydrated food, or guided tours of the "Holy Land." Our only mrechandise is ideas. We have not fat cats purring in our lap. Our only financial support comes from you.

If you want to help us make THE LIBERTY BELL bigger and better, here are a few things you can do:

CONTRIBUTE

to THE LIBERTY BELL whatever you can. A regular small contribution is just as helpful as an occasional large one. Indeed, in the long run it's better. If you will allow us a bit of wishful thinking: Were 500 of our subscribers each to contribute \$5.00 per month — which is about the price of a carton of coffin nails or a monthly subscription to a daily jewspaper — our income would probably keep pace with our "outgo." Whether your financial support takes the form of a \$50.00 or a \$5.00 donation, the important thing is that it be regular and sustained.

CIRCULATE

THE LIBERTY BELL. If there is anything we like better than outright financial support, it is the financial and moral support that comes with a book order, with a new or renewed subscription, Help get THE LIBERTY BELL new readers, new subscribers, new supporters by purchasing books and entering gift subscriptions for your friends, relatives, co-workers, neighbors, and the local library. College libraries are especially important recipients of gift subscriptions and books. Our "market research" has shown that THE LIBERTY BELL has considerable appeal to young White people, and unless we reach more of them, our cause is lost, If you would like us to select a library for a gratis subscription, just send us your donation and we'll do the rest. (Remember: When a library receives a gift subscription paved in advance for several years, it will generally add the periodical to its reference collection.) By subsidizing these gift subscriptions, you will help our race reclaim its own. You should always carry a copy of THE LIBERTY BELL or a pamphlet like The Destiny of America on your person, so that when you meet somebody who is responsive to our ideas you will have literature for him. Some of us still have the old "right wing" defeatist attitude about distributing literature to "strangers." Let's put that nonsense out of our heads! We can be just as effective pamphlet-mongers as any millgate or mortarboard Bolsheviks, Hare Krishnas, or Moses Davidites, And we have something worthwhile to sell. In this land of millions, there are tens of thousands of people who would immediately enter a subscription to THE LIBERTY BELL if ever they read through a copy. Your task is to find them and place that first copy in their hands, just as somebody once placed in your hands the book or magazine that brought you into the movement. So get a group of your friends together and hit the bricks!

And you should at least try to get THE LIBERTY BELL sold at newsstands and shops. "If the proprietor complains that he dare not sell it," says one of our young supporters, "ask him why he sells Hustler and The Village Voice 1 o u d, so his customers can hear!" When it comes to distributing THE LIBERTY BELL, don't be afraid to be a "pushy goy."

COLLABORATE

in producing THE LIBERTY BELL. We need writers who are prepared to accept assignments and contribute regularly. Right now, our great need is for well-written, concise reviews (500 to 1000 words, let us say) of titles

on the Liberty Bell Publications list. Letters are always welcome, of course, but it would be nice if some of our faithful correspondents would expend a little more time and effort and contribute proper articles. If you have ambitions to write, here is your opportunity. "With all the publicity about 'freedom of expression' being protected by the liberals and the Jew-dominated ACLU," writes our contributor Carl Alessi, "it is really only in publications like yours that an unknown writer can expect to see his words printed undistorted and unedited." The one thing we demand of our contributors is discipline: We don't want slapdash outpourings in tin-eared rightwingese — and, yes, we have published our share of those — but well-researched, well-reasoned, well-organized pieces in clear, unpretentious English.

Other publications on the "Right" do a splendid job of reporting events and analysing issues, of elucidating the ideology and positions of a political party, of gently opening minds bunged shut in the colleges, and they deserve your support, too. But as a general forum of ideas and opinions, THE LIBERTY BELL occupies a unique position in the movement. We shall do our best to sustain the qualitative improvement in our publication. We ask you to help produce the quantitative one.
