Saturday evening.

My Darling Wife,

Hello, honey. Moved today. Left Wengen about noon and arrived here in Lucerne about 5:00 pm.

Yesterday afternoon we went up the Jungfrau Mt. above Wengen to the summit by tram (known as the Jungfrau bahn). This railroad is the highest in Europe and the hotel on Jungfrau is the highest hotel in Europe - 11,347 feet.

I bought some picture postcards
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at Wengen and at Jungfrau which I will send to you later. I also have taken two rolls of film and have purchased two other rolls.

I had the two rolls developed and printed at Wengen and got 15 shots that are good. I will send these to you after I get back to Germany also.

I have some pamphlets and literature about the hotel Balances pictured on this stationery and which is my abode for two nights, and will send that later as well.

Things happen too fast for me to remember all the things I want to tell you about, honey, but I will do my best. Such beautiful scenery I never saw before in

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my life. Wengen and surrounding territory must undoubtedly be one of the most beautiful spots in the World. The snapshots I took will help me remember little stories I want to tell you when I can show you the pictures.

Darling, I must close now and get ready for dinner. I will try to write again tomorrow.

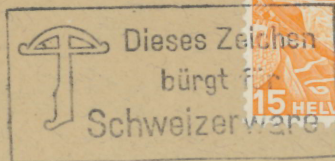
