24 October 1945
Wednesday.

My Darling Wife,

Just a few lines, honey, to let you know that I am to leave the 90th Div tomorrow morning for the 3rd Reinforcement Depot. From there I should begin the long trek thru transient reinforcement camps to the port, the boat, and then to the good old U.S.A.

I do not know how fast I will move but know that the Reinforcement System is known to be slow going and I don't know how often I will move.

I will write whenever we stop but a good deal of the time may be spent moving or processing.

I hope to be home about mid-December.

Until my next letter and maybe more definite news, remember that I am thinking of you and Laura, praying for you, and loving you.
