**General Conditions of Issue.**

1. This document relates only to the identity of the person described. It is not available as a Passport, Pass or Permit.
2. The loss of this Identity Card will be reported at once to the O.C. the Unit to which the holder belongs. The holder should make a separate note of the number of his card.
3. Anyone finding this card should hand it to the nearest Military establishment.
4. Impersonation of the authorised Bearer of an Identity Card or its alteration, destruction or transfer to another person are penal offences.
5. No indication will be given on this card of the regiment, corps formation or unit to which the holder belongs. In the event of change of name or other particulars, a fresh card will be issued.
6. An officer ceasing to be employed in a capacity in which the wearing of uniform is permitted, will return his A.F.B.2606 A to the O.C. Unit.
