Many thanks for your letter of 13 August. The extra information was just what we needed, and I am happy to say that we have now been able to get in touch with Mrs Obodowska, who is at present in Malmo, Sweden.

She was very ill with typhus, and pneumonia, but is now recovered.

We have been very lucky with our negotiations over passports and visas, and everything seems to be laid on now, so that it is only a question of transport. With any luck she should be with us for Christmas.

I am very pleased to hear that you are back home again - and demobilised too! I have had just six years in the Army, four of them in the Middle East, and am expecting to be demobilised early next year. I think it is just about nine-six years is a good slice out of anyone's life. The four years overseas have not bothered me, since after meeting my fiancée out here I have not felt any great longing to go back to England, but to many of our fellows, especially the married ones, it has been a very long time.

Once again may I thank you for your help, for which we shall always be grateful.
