- 13. 9. 40. Came to see me. Has had to move. Mr. Urin's house has been bombed & they have moved to their daughter's. Went to her sister, Sonia's, last night. Now they both have to move. ^{see} Has found job as millinery trainee with Messrs. Park Smith. 114/117 Riddlesee St. E. 1. Earns 18/- per week. Sent to 243 Willesden Lane
- 16. 9. 40. Sent to see Miss Jewel about a job.
- 9. 12. 40. Asked to call and see Mr. Allerhand re storing luggage.
- 7/1/41 Came to ask for money for Tati, as she took luggage to Bloomsbury House to be stored - ^{see} B
- 23. 1. 41 ^{her} Lanya came about being a doctor - said we could arrange for him to come, could be next week - but I don't know. So Lisa came to see Dr. Newnes - He wishes to have her chest X-rayed & has sent her with a letter to St. Mary's Hospital, Paddington - does not think she has T.B. B
- 11. 10. 41. Letter to Mrs. Edkins from Miss Feldman informg. her that Lisa's firm have agreed to let her have an afternoon off every week so that she can take additional music lessons (for which Mrs. Edkins kindly agreed to pay) until she takes exam. in Nov. (HF)
- 13. 10. 41. b Letter recd. from Mrs. Edkins confirmg. 'phone conversation she had with Miss Braddell re. extra lessons for Jura, etc. This letter ackn. ~~and~~ by Miss Feldman. Mrs. Hardisty informed, also that we have written and asked Lisa whether she will be self-supportg. (HF)
- 20. 10. 41. Lisa has written to say that she can manage to pay her own expenses. (HF)

27.11.41. Letter to Mrs. Edkins from Miss Feldman, informg. her that Miss Floyd 'phoned other day to ask if 3 additional lessons (GM) cd. be given to Lisa before exam; Miss F. gave permission; now asks if this is all right.

8.12.41. Miss Floyd, Lisa's music-teacher 'phoned Miss Feldman to say that Lisa had passed Theory exam of Nov. 19th. with 100% marks. She is (GM) to take a Practical exam on Sat; All these prior to scholarship which she hopes to take at Easter time. Mrs. Hardisty and Mrs. Laski informed. Letter of congratulation sent to Lisa.

16-2-42. Mrs. Cohn informed Miss Feldman girl had changed her job.
LHS. 28-2-42. T.1 sent.

16/3/42. R.S. Milliner at Roney Buggs & Co. 35/7, Oxford St. W.1. £2.10. p.w.
24.4.42. Letter to Mrs. Edkins, from Miss Feldman, statg. that Miss (GM/89) Floyd has 'phoned us - she is rather worried as she has written twice this yr. to Mrs. Edkins abt. Lisa's future musical education, and wd. like to know what Mrs. E. thinks abt. this; and asks her to write to Miss Floyd as soon as poss.
1.5.42. Reply from Mrs. Edkins. Has changed address to
44, GRAND AVENUE N 10. (TOD 2538)

6.8.42. Girl called to inform Miss Feldman that she had passed the Final (HF/GM) Exam prior to the L.R.A.M. with distinctions. She now wants to sit for a scholarship, and asked if it wd. be poss. for her to move from the Hostel and live in a room of her own where she wd. have the opportunity of practising and quiet study. Told Lisa that it wd. be much better if we cd. find a room where she cd. just practice, but still remain in the Hostel for her food, etc.
Miss Floyd, the teacher, 'phoned later, also notifying us of result of Lisa's exam. She is delighted with the girl's progress and hopes that Lisa will be able to sit for a scholarship next Easter, which, if she passes, will carry with it a Maintenance Grant. Miss Feldman will endeavour to find a family in the district, who possess a piano and who wd. be willg. to allow Lisa the use of it. Consulted Dr. Van der Zyl with regard to this.

10.11.42. Lisa came in to report that she had strained her wrist whilst (GM/89) at work (machining). It was very painful, and she could not practise on the piano. Sent her to Mrs. Vitoria. Mrs. Cohn 'phoned later abt. this. Sd. that girl wd. not move just yet, under these circumstances.

2.12.42. Lisa came in to say that wrist was much better and that she was (GM/89) returng. to work on Monday next, 7th. She is makg. arrangements to move to 32, Marlow Ct, Willesden Lane, N.W.2, where she had found v. suitable accomtn, in the flat of a nice couple. (She had reported this to us on 9th Nov). Will have to pay 35/- p.w. for b/l. Mrs. Cohn had inspected this and found it v. suitable indeed.

9-12-42. Tl. to girl in view of change of work. LHS.

26.2.43. Letter from Mrs. K. Edkins re. scholarships that Lisa cd. enter (GM/89) for, but statg. that she can take no financial responsibility for Lisa beyond the payment of tuition fees up to the time of her takg. the examination.

27.2.43. Miss Floyd 'phoned, Wanted to know what we were going to do abt. (GM/89) Lisa and the scholarships. Told her that the Movement cd. not possibly sign guarantee for girl's maintenance. Miss Floyd sent letter to us, with entry forms for the exams.

3.3.43. Lisa came up. Told her we cd. not help her financially. Sd. she (GM/89) wd. try and get her relatives to sign guarantee form for her. Phoned later to say that Miss Floyd had agreed to sign the form. Sent her statement, as requested, that according to our knowledge she is a Jewess; this is needed for the Guarantee Form.

17.3.43. Letter to Mrs. Edkins, informg. her of what has been arranged and (GM/89) thankg. her for her kind help and interest.

27.5.43 Mrs Woyda to visit T. M.

2nd and 6th June, 1943. Visited by Mrs. Woyda. V. nice home, where (GM/89) Lisa is v. happy - the Gowers lookg. after her v. well. Has full bd. Mrs. Gower stated that Lisa is a gd. and helpful girl. Lisa did not get the scholarship, which was given to a 15 yr. old girl, who is not liable for war work - there were 75 applicants altogether, and Lisa and this girl were the only two prospects. She is continuing

with her lessons, & hopes to be able to play at some ENSA Concerts. Goes rambling with young Mr. Uq. Is involic pair at SK Lux, Buxton Rd, Acton, W.3. Attends P. M. A. College at Borehamwood, for typing.
