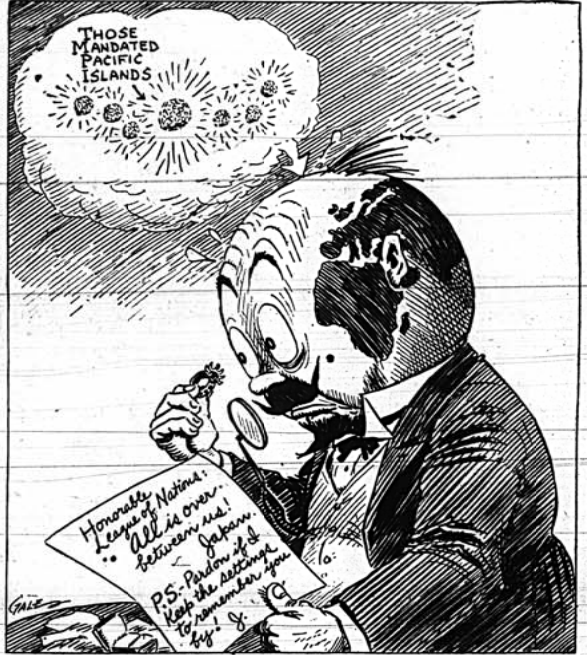

Defense of Jews Resented

Business With Foreigners in Germany to Feel Effects of Retaliation Move

Reports Abroad of Atrocities Bring Steps to Limit Hebrews in Professions

BERLIN, March 27. (AP)—Adolf Hitler's Nazi party answered foreign threats of boycotts against German goods today by announcing a movement to boycott Jewish business establishments within the Reich.
