While the emotion-mongers have been marching all over the nation, the watershed of opinion is becoming more discernible on the American horizon as communists and anti-communists follow their distinctively separate routes in opposite directions.

101 Communism forms one heavy stream on its side of the watershed, with every issue blending into the final end-- a world collectivist state under a Rule of Law. The means to that end are plain: racial integration, disarming of all free nations--except Israel, the UN as a tool with Red China seated and votes for all satellite and colored nations, overthrow of colonialism (white governments), increased immigration of non-whites and non-Christians, socialization such as urban renewal and war on poverty, foreign aid, banning of Christian religious observances and loyalty oaths, twisted court decisions, and destruction of culture and morals.

100 The technique is blackmail: Coexistence or nuclear war; obscenity or no freedom of speech and press; an unarmed citizenry or more assassinations, and so on.

100 Senator Paul Douglas's wife marched with the communists, as did other white Americans who deem themselves of irreproachable respectability.

the people. Never before has a cause sprung from the roots--from the consciences of the citizens, without a leader.

The War of Independence was won by leaders. The Civil War and French Revolution were started by a few agitators and should never have taken place. Both World Wars were the product of the high and mighty, and the people who fought them had nothing to say in the matter.

Our victory will be the first to prove that a people can defend their principles, and that government of, by, and for the people can function in a crisis.
