returned to this office together with all the documentary evidence listed  
in Paragraph 8 of the forms. Supporting documents should consist of birth  
certificate, Certificate of Legal Residence or Domicile, passport, or any  
other document which will help to support your request for amendment of  
your registration records. Photostatic or certified copies of the docu-  
ments may be submitted and one copy of each document will be sufficient

Do not submit documents issued by the United States Government  
such as a Declaration of Intention, Immigrant Identification Card, etc.  
If you have no documents to submit, please answer Item 8 by inserting the  
word "none".

When returning the enclosed forms, please indicate the location  
of the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation noted in your Certi-  
ficate of Identification.

Please do not call at this office in person or telephone regard-  
ing the status of your application. Such inquiries should be made by mail  
and the file number appearing in the upper right hand corner of this letter  
should be quoted.
