declare hereby this affidavit with full knowledge of the importance of such a declaration:

" Since April 1941-April nineteen hundred forty one- we were together with Elemer K i s s , merchant from Veszprem/Hungary at a Labor Camp in the Ukraine. We were assigned to labor behind the Front (trench digging etc.) In April 1942- April nineteen hundred forty two- Mr. Kiss died from physical debility in this Labor Camp near Kiev. We saw his body and have buried him ourselves.

We have known Mr. Kiss already before we came together to the Labor Camp "
