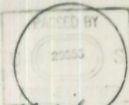

ENGLAND.

I believe that I told you before we are paid in English money and use nothing but English money over here. It doesn't seem quite so strange now, but it bothered a little at first.

Although there are a few pieces of English money that are very rare, and we have not seen them, we ordinarily have the following:

	One Pound Note	1 £	1 £ (20 shillings)	\$4.00
