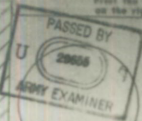

Dear Dad & Mother,

FRANCE - 28 AUGUST 1944 - Monday

Well, we have been on the move so much the last few days that I haven't written. We have been through a lot of pretty French countryside and some towns & villages.

Every time we stop the French children fairly swarm over the vehicles to shake hands and greet us with "Bonjour." Often they give us apples, tomatoes, cider, wine, etc. & throw flowers. The boys all throw "K" ration hard candy to the kids & "K" ration cigarettes to the Frenchmen.

Not much news except that we work and we move & then when we stop we take up where we left off. We sleep out in the woods in pup tents. We eat sitting on our helmets with our mess kits on our knees or on the ground. When we work, though, we are fortunate in that our unit has the large vans to work in. So much for now. Goodnight & may God bless you.
