My thoughts have been more than ever with you today, darling, but I have been so busy that I hardly had time to think and now that I am home at last it is time to go to bed. I have to get up a little earlier than usual tomorrow.

Being Monday today, and due to the fact that another of my men is gone on pass to Paris, I was unusually busy.

time the Captain came back
from a meeting at Third
Army and said I was to
go to Munich tonight for
my physical exam to be an
Officer. I left right after
chow and just got back
but did not get the exam.
I have to go back to Munich
the first thing in the morning.

the works - I don't know.
I'll let you know more as time
goes on but right now I must
call time out and admit it
is bedtime.

am thinking of you, loving you, and
praying for you.
