



3 DPA SERIES: THE NAZI HOLOCAUST — Forty-six thousand Jews resisted the SS, the German tanks, and Wehrmacht troops sent to flush them out of the Warsaw Ghetto. They had only small arms and homemade grenades (made in a variety of camouflaged bunkers and workshops) with which to fight the heavily armed Germans. About 100,000 Jews were killed in the Holocaust.
