and said Berta Forchheimer, and two children, Franz and Anne
Forchheimer, are in good health and physical condition, mentally
sound, and of best moral character.

That my regular occupation is Merchant.

That I am sole owner and manager of L. Forchheimer
Store, located in Alpine, Brewster County, Texas.

That my weekly earnings amount of about \$225.00

That my present dependents consist of my wife and one
child.

That I am willing and able to support, and to be
responsible for the said Emil Forchheimer and Berta Forchheimer,
